Tips For Protecting Water Pipes and Sanity

We haved had residents with leaking water pipes due to the cold weather! Please keep in mind that this is dangerous and a major pain to deal with. Here are a few suggestion to stay vigilent:

• If it's 20° or below, turn your heat up a few degrees and open the cabinet doors under the kitchen sink or any room with pipes. that are on the outside walls.



- Possibly place a small, non-coil space heater in the kitchen or room where pipes are on outside walls.
- Make sure that pets are all indoors and safe.
- In case there's an emergency, **know how to turn off the main water valve that feeds your unit.** Then call a board member and have the number close by for your insurance company as well.
- · Keep garage doors closed because this lets arctic winter air into the units above.
- · Let your faucet drip as well.
