

As the year winds down many people take time to reflect on the past and make plans for the future. This year my plans for the future include evaluating ways to save on my budget for 2024.

The most substantial change that I've made is cutting the cable cord! By purchasing a FireStick you can watch some live TV, local and national news, your favorite TV shows and Movies. I save \$110 each month! You need an internet

connection and a Firestick which is available at your favorite retailer as well as Amazon. You can purchase it for \$25-\$59. It's a one time purchase.

Your TV screen will look like this and you



click through the menu for different channels. There's a "live" TV button on the screen and your remote to get live TV. Like anything new, it takes a bit to become familiar with navigating. You can subscribe to additional streaming services (Netflix, Brit-box, Hulu, etc.) for an additional fee through the subscriber.



### Update cell plan.

Another money saver was switching my Verizon phone service from the *5G Play More* plan to the *Unlimited Welcome* plan saving \$15 a month. As the name suggests, it includes unlimited talk, text and data. The only difference is that I may be downgraded to a slower data speed if the network is super busy. So far, I haven't experienced any delays.



### Review your savings account.

### Preparing for Winter in your Condo

It's that time of year. The snow starts flying and a chill fills the air. Preparing your home ahead of winter can keep you more comfortable and reduce heating bills.

- Replace weatherstripping around your entry doors
- Have your furnace inspected and filter replaced to confirm it's operating at peak performance.

- Adding insulation on your garage door and sprinkler pipes in the garage will keep the space a little warmer and help prevent pipes from freezing in extreme cold.
- Experts suggest allowing your cold water faucet to drip if overnight temps are projected to be anywhere near the 20 degree mark or below. Also, keep your cabinet doors and dishwasher open overnight if your sink and dishwasher are on an exterior wall.
